Sub: Request for CSR funds / Sponsorship for distribution of Cyber Safety Kits in Schools for prevention of sextortion crimes – in Partnership with ISAC

There is a rising sexual crime in form of online blackmail and sextortion against women and kids across India, especially targeting school children.

What is Sextortion / Online Blackmail?

Sextortion is a relatively new form of sexual exploitation that occurs primarily online and in which non-physical forms of coercion are utilized, such as blackmail, to acquire sexual content (photos/videos) of the child, obtain money from the child or engage in sex with the child

Some of the most common methods used:

- 1. Getting a phone number of girl / women from pre-paid recharge shops and harassing them with calls, constant messages and forwards with sexual content
- 2. Hacking passwords of Facebook and email accounts to hijack them and threaten to post or send explicit sexual content to friends and relatives unless demands are met
- 3. Use SMS, Facebook Chat, WhatsApp, Webcam etc to flirt romantically and later threaten to send screenshots or videos to parents and friends

Disturbing Global Statistics

- 78% of the reports involved female children and 15% involved male children (In 8% of reports, child gender could not be determined).
- Male and female children each ranged in age from 8-17 years old and had an average age of fifteen years old; however, compared to female children, it was less common for male children to be on the younger end of the spectrum.
- In 24% of the reports, reporters mentioned that they suspected or knew that additional children were targeted by the same offender

How ISAC is making a difference

Information Sharing and Analysis Center (ISAC) is a registered non-profit organization since 2011 that is engaged in creating cyber safety awareness among children. For the past 5 years, ISAC foundation has relentlessly worked towards improving cyber security awareness among people from all age groups and undertaken various initiatives in this direction for the sole purpose of CSR.

- The kid-friendly superhero "Hanubot" created by ISAC has been termed by **AMAZON INDIA** as "one of the most innovative and useful products" and has been shortlisted for the special Amazon Launch Pad program
- DELHI PUBLIC SCHOOL (DPS) is the first school chain in India that has acknowledged the magnitude of sextortion problem and to protect children, the school has made the ISAC cyber safety kit "mandatory" for all children from 5th to 10th standard.
- Over **3 lakh school students** from various schools across India have benefited from workshops and seminars, driven by ISAC volunteers in last 5 years
- To support victims affected by sextortion and online blackmail, ISAC setups "Cyber Law Intervention Center for Kids" (CLICK) Center in schools that provides free legal aid and cyber safety awareness training to parents

Cost of one camp can vary between Rupees 5 to 30 lakhs depending upon the no. of beneficiary students (1000 – 6000).

We may take up such camps in different parts of the country (as per the requirement of your organization) for which ISAC will do the preliminary assessment or baseline survey for the schools and their student strengths. Incase ISAC organizes the camps, an additional amount @10% of the cost of cyber safety kits, workshops and establishment of CLICK center for training parents and teachers shall be charged by ISAC towards the cost of event management.
